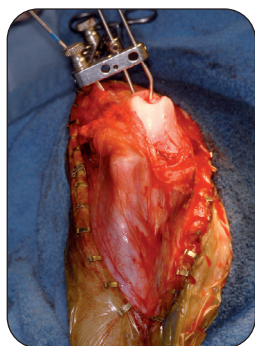

- How to perform physical examination and diagnostic imaging
- Application of the CORA method for correction of limb deformities
- Planning for correction of different limb deformities (Valgus, varus, torsion of femur and tibia)
- Joint and soft tissue treatment of patellar luxation
- Know-how:
 - Practical exercise of radiographic measurement on digital radiographs for medial patellar luxation and for lateral patellar luxation

SECOND DAY, TUESDAY MAY 20th

- How to perform distal femoral corrective osteotomy (DFO)
- How to perform proximal tibial corrective osteotomy (PTO)
- Know-how:
 - Practical exercise of preoperative planning for DFO and PTO on digital films
 - Dry-lab of DFO and PTO on plastic bones
 - Wet-lab of DFO and PTO on cadavers

THIRD DAY, WEDNESDAY MAY 21th

- Understanding several variables in patellar luxation, like concomitant cruciate failure, immature dogs, toy breeds, challenging cases
- Knowing a new tool for chronic and complex patellar luxations, the trochlear groove prosthesis
- How to approach tibial deformities in growing dogs
- How to realign rear limb malunions
- Approaching metatarsal rotation
- When femoral and tibial lengthening are required
